Visitation Policy

Inpatient Visitation Guidelines:

- Visiting Hours: 7 a.m. 9 p.m. After Hours Visitation
 must be pre-approved by departmental staff or physician.
 Once approval is received, staff will provide additional
 access information.
- A designated caregiver may stay overnight in the patient's room. In addition to the designated caregiver, four visitors will be allowed for a total of five at a time in a patient's room.
- All visitors must check in at an information desk for a guest pass specific to patient being visited.
 Guest passes should be visible at all times.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult and cannot be left unattended while at the hospital.

- Visitors with symptoms of a cold, flu, or other contagious illness are asked to refrain from visiting patients.
- Shirts and shoes are required. Any visitor wearing clothing that is deemed inappropriate will be asked to leave.
- Hand sanitizer stations are placed throughout the facility for visitors.
- Visitors may access cafeteria and concession areas, but otherwise should remain in the patient's room they are visiting.

Below exceptions may apply:

- Emergency Center: One visitor is allowed to be with patient at all times.
- Pediatric: Two designated caregivers are permitted at all times.
- Swing Bed Unit: One visitor is allowed to be with the patient at all times.
- Exceptions may be made in special circumstances or end-of-life.
